- May Revise May 14th
- House of Origin Deadline June 4th
- Budget Floor Vote June 15th
- Policy Committee Deadline July 14th
- Summer Recess July 16th through August 16th
- Fiscal Deadline August 27th
- Floor Deadline September 10th
- Sign/Veto Deadline October 10th

Item	Amount	Location	Legislative Blueprint
Housing and Homelessness (65,000 off the streets)	\$12 billion	May Revision	\$8.5 billion with \$1 billion in ongoing flexible funding for local governments
Renters Pay	\$5.2 billion	May Revision	As proposed
Broadband Expansion	\$7 billion	May Revision/Leg. Agreement	\$7 billion placeholder language
Rail & Active Transportation Projects	\$3.1 billion	May Revision/Leg. Agreement	\$3 billion placeholder for projects completed before 2028
Highway, Bridges, Rail Repairs	\$2.4 billion/ \$2 billion for streets roads and highway projects	May Revision/ Leg. Agreement	\$2 billion for streets, roads and highway projects
